
AT THE CENTER: YOUR LIFE PLAN

The central activity of the summer is a process we call Lifeⁿ. This process helps you develop a life plan that is biblical, that uniquely fits you, and that helps you see what to do now in order to build a powerful future.

The Lifeⁿ process will take you through the following steps.

- My Story—What is My Past and Where am I Going?
- My Purpose—Why Do I Exist?
- My Abilities—What are My Unique Contributions?
- My Legacy—What am I Intentionally Passing On?
- My Strategy—How Do I Make My Legacy a Reality?
- My Habits—How Can I Pursue Lifelong Learning?

You will gain better answers to urgent questions by seeing the fuller picture of how God has designed life to work. Questions like... Am I in the right major? How does my faith connect to school and work? What do I do after I graduate? Who do I marry? How can I be fulfilled and happy? During Immerse you will deal with these questions head on and gain clarity on achieving the potential the Lord created you to have.



BE CHANGED BY GOD'S WORD

Many of us long for a real experience with God. The problem is that we often separate this pursuit from any deep interaction with God's Word. The living God has revealed Himself in the Word, but we can't find Him there! One goal of Immerse is that you learn to think biblically and regain the vanishing ability of encountering God in His Word.

Over the summer you will tackle two strategic sections of Scripture. You will make discoveries and develop convictions that give you clarity on your own life purpose.

ACTS

The book of Acts will give you a sweeping, big-picture view of our Lord's mission. You will see what He is working to accomplish from the first century until the day He returns. Most importantly, you will think through how your own life fits into His plan.

PAUL'S LETTERS

It is popular today to love Jesus but not love the church. From these Scriptures you will find that the Church and the churches are actually the centerpiece of our Lord's work. Further, you will discover your role in making a church community be an authentic, dynamic, and life-changing family.

BE IMPACTED BY COMMUNITY

During the summer you will participate in (not "attend") The CityChurch of Ames. A key reason for Immerse's impact is the unique way it is woven into the community life of a church and of a city-wide network. You will make friends. You will get to know people, older and younger, who want to know you and will take time to invest in your life. You will take part in the following community experiences:



MENTORING

You will meet throughout the summer with a well-equipped, older mentor who will help you think through critical issues and truly internalize what you are learning from the Scriptures.



MINISTRY RESPONSIBILITY

Although you will see many informal opportunities for ministry, you will be asked to assist in a specific ministry sphere within The CityChurch. The responsibility will fit you but also stretch you. You will grow in ministry skills as we assess and equip you in this hands-on context.



LIFE ON LIFE

You will find yourself shaped as people from your church family take an interest in your development. Relationships will emerge spontaneously, but we will also organize strategic opportunities for you to interact with leaders, older families, and mature peers.



GIFTS ASSESSMENT

Your gifts will be assessed as you are observed engaging in ministry and participating in the church family. This, in conjunction with a well-constructed giftedness discovery process, will begin to give you a sense of how God has uniquely wired you.

SEE THE GLOBAL PICTURE

The CityChurch of Ames-Des Moines spear-heads an international ministry working to train leaders and establish churches around the world. We are currently involved in 40 countries on 6 continents, including areas of Southeast Asia where the gospel is expanding rapidly.

Periodically during the summer and at a mid-summer retreat, you will be exposed to visionary leaders from this ministry network. You will see how the principles you are learning in Immerse work out on a world scale. And you will be challenged to think about how your life fits into God's global mission.

A highlight of the summer will be a visit to one of our USA partner churches. There you will see how principles you are learning are being used in an entirely different ministry context.

IS IMMERSE WORTH YOUR TIME?

That is a vital question to ask. In fact, we do not want you to participate in Immerse unless you can answer this question with a clear "yes."

The following answers to common questions may help you decide:

I WANT A SIGNIFICANT MINISTRY EXPERIENCE THIS SUMMER, LIKE CAMP COUNSELING OR A SHORT-TERM MISSION TRIP. HOW DOES IMMERSE COMPARE?

Excellent question! We believe Immerse will have every bit as much impact in your life as other options you are considering, and quite possibly more so. Here's why...



Immerse targets your total life.

We give you a great threemonth experience, but our vision goes far beyond the summer. We help you develop in ways that will steer your walk with Christ over your lifetime.



Immerse makes you effective in ministry.

You develop convictions that keep you aligned with the Lord's priorities as you rethink all areas of your life.



Immerse connects you with older and wiser Christ-followers.

You will minister with great people your age, but some of your deepest memories will be of talks you had with godly older members of the church family.



CAN I DO IMMERSE AND TAKE COLLEGE CLASSES AT THE SAME TIME?

A: The issues raised during Immerse are absolutely strategic and need to be given attention. Therefore, we encourage students to give Immerse priority and avoid the added distraction of college classes during the summer. A single class can be managed if you are disciplined and motivated.

O: I NEED TO MAKE MONEY THIS SUMMER. CAN I DO IMMERSE AND WORK AT THE SAME TIME?

We encourage you to have a less-than-full-time job. We assume most of you will need to make some income over the summer. However, Immerse requires a commitment that will be difficult to fulfill working full-time. If you need work and are coming from out of town, we can assist you in finding a job in Ames (a university town with many part-time summer positions). We can also arrange for you to live with a family in order to reduce your expenses.

KEY DETAILS TO KNOW

WHAT WILL I DO WITH MY TIME?

Each week will be a bit different, but you can normally expect the following:

- 6 hours in the three core discussion groups (Acts, Paul's Letters, Lifeⁿ), usually held on a couple of evening or early morning time slots.
- 6 hours in Bible study and preparation for discussions.
- 5 hours carrying out assigned or spontaneous ministry.
- 20-30 hours working a part-time job.
- Participating in the weekly gatherings of The CityChurch (Sunday morning and evening).
- Enjoying informal time with other apprentices (Saturday ultimate frisbee and pizza has been a favorite).
- Catching lunch with your mentors.

As you can see, the weeks are filled. Don't let this scare you. We have experience with making the summer intense but not overwhelming. We will work with your schedule and make adjustments as needed.



WILL I NEED A CAR?

Wheels are nice, but not absolutely necessary. Housing is available in Ames, and transportation can be arranged for the various Immerse functions.

WHAT WILL IT COST?

Tuition for Immerse will be \$500. This covers the cost of:

- Course materials
- Staffing
- · Technology improvement
- Coursework assessment

WHAT WILL WE EXPECT FROM YOU?


- 1. Genuine interest in maturing in your faith. Don't do this because someone talks you into it.
