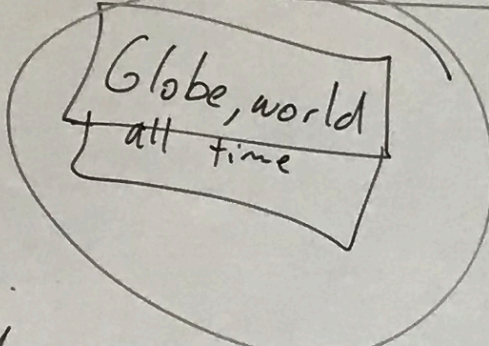
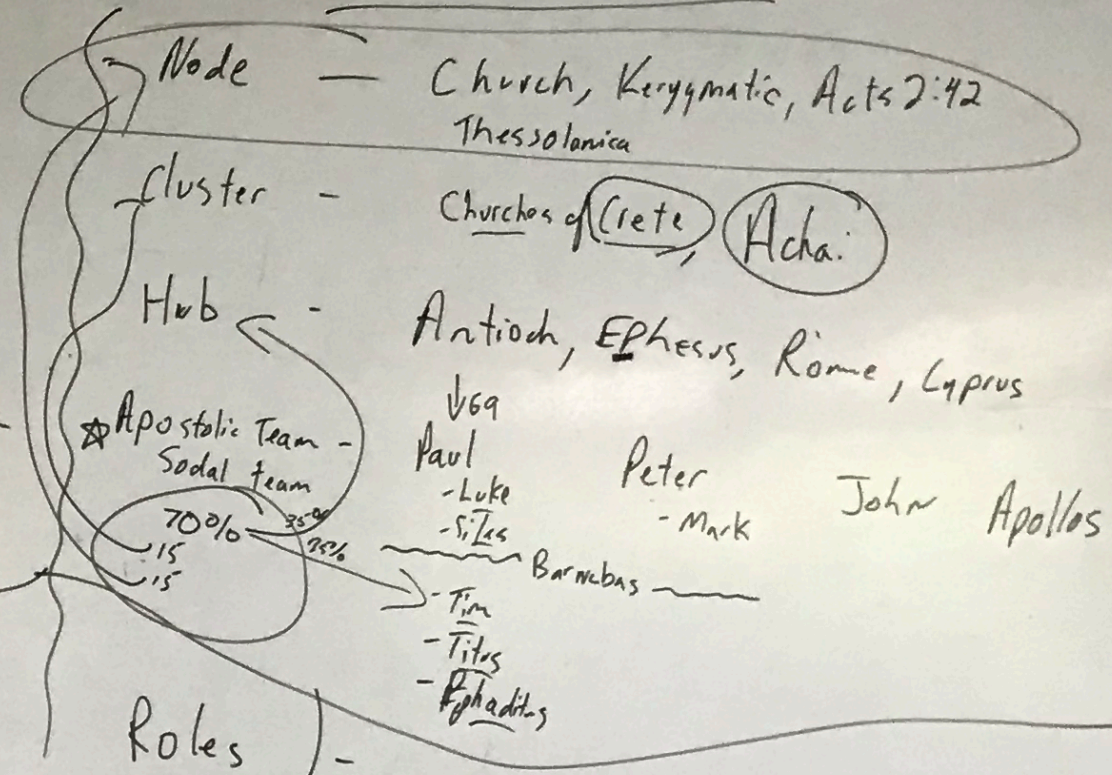
Network of families
