

- "You are the salt of the earth"; "You are the light of the world" (Mt 5.13,14)
- "I am sending you out like sheep into the midst of wolves; so be wise as serpents and innocent as doves" (Mt 10.16)
- "Love your neighbors as yourselves" (Mt 22.39)

 - Michael: "Christ's principles must be integrated into our churches' and individual's lives, or else our faith is actually dead."












- Theology in Culture is...
