As I reflect on my past, my own understanding of how to use these books, I have previously thought the gospel books are used for: • It is where the "gospel readings" come from in church services • This is where we learn to be more like Jesus • These are the books where the main message of Jesus is found • This is where most sermons for the church services come from, one

- verse at a time
- as they are not Jesus' words

The other parts of the New Testament are different, separate, detached

• Jesus taught in stories and parables, so that we can understand

# **BILD** Apostolic Team - The Work Accomplished

Working with Church networks be Strong and to Multiply Caleb...and all of the ADMCC network

- Traveled and met with existing networks in about 35 countries
- Cluster meetings across Asia 40 large networks
- City Initiatives USA, traveled to 6 cities, 3-4 times each
- Relaunched Latin America work, 15 countries participating
- Began 127 bible projects (98 in 2016), 25 have first draft of NT completed
- Started improvements for Antioch School 2.0
- Raised support for BILD, and partners, over \$1.1mil, with another \$300k gift in kind
- Continually solidifying leaders in about 60 key cohorts
- Put more framework in place for all BILD resources to be translated into all GW languages
