Gut Check

- Music: response to...
 - ...being filled with the Spirit
 - ...the word of Christ dwelling in us richly
- Music: response to gratitude!
- If we're not (at *least* some of us, guiding the rest of us) responding in song, what's that say about us? [...]
- DON'T MAKE AN IDOL OF TALENT

Definition of Music and the Arts

 In the context of the church, music and the arts are a creative response, in a variety of media, to all that God has, is, and will accomplish.

Music and Arts Guild

Purpose of the Guild

 The Music and Arts Guild has three purposes. The Guild *creates* artistic content that represents biblical theology in the form of artistic expression. The Guild equips the churches to understand music and the arts, and equips artists to bring art into the churches. The Guild *leads* by demonstrating, to the churches and artists, how to participate in music and the arts, through creation and presentation of artifacts, and by leading during network gatherings.
