A Young Church

1 Thessalonians 3:6–10 (NASB95)

⁶ But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and has brought us good news of your faith and love, and that you always think kindly of us, longing to see us just as we also long to see you, ⁷ for this reason, brethren, in all our distress and affliction we were comforted about you through your faith; 8 for now we *really* live, if you **stand firm** in the Lord. ⁹ For what thanks can we render to God for you in return for all the joy with which we rejoice before our God on your account, ¹⁰ as we night and day keep praying most earnestly that we may see your face, and may complete what is lacking in your faith?

2 Thessalonians 2:15–17 (NASB95)

¹⁵ So then, brethren, **stand firm** and **hold to the traditions** which you were taught, whether by word *of mouth* or by letter from us. ¹⁶ Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who has loved us and given us eternal comfort and good hope by grace, ¹⁷ comfort and strengthen your hearts in every good work and word.

An Established Church

Philippians 1:27 (NASB95)

²⁷ Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear of you that you are **standing firm** in one spirit, with one mind **striving together** for the faith of the gospel;

Leaders

Titus 1:10,16 – 2:2 (NASB95)

¹⁰ For there are many rebellious men, empty talkers and deceivers... ¹⁶ They profess to know God, but by *their* deeds they deny *Him*, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed. ¹ But as for you, speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine. ² Older men are to be temperate, dignified, sensible, sound in faith, in love, in **perseverance**.

1 Timothy 4:15–16 (NASB95)

¹⁵ Take pains with these things; be *absorbed* in them, so that your **progress** will be evident to all. ¹⁶ Pay close attention to yourself and to your teaching; **persevere** in these things, for as you do this you will ensure salvation both for yourself and for those who hear you.

The Terms

Define the words

- Stand firm stand, hold firm, continue in a state
- Persevere continue in an activity or state

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Thessalonica

What did a young church need?

- They needed to continue to be taught (1 Thess 3:2,10)
- They needed to be assessed What is lacking? (1 Thess 3:10)
- They needed perspective on hard stuff (1 Thess 3:3-5)
- They needed to hold to the traditions (2 Thess 2:15)

Thessalonica

Note that the entire church was to hold to the traditions

- What processes would need to be in place?
- What would potentially disrupt or shake a church's hold on the traditions?
- How would a leader go about assessing what is lacking at a point in time?

Philippians 1:27 (NASB95)

²⁷ Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear of you that you are **standing firm** in one spirit, with one mind **striving together** for the faith of the gospel;

Philippi

What did a more established church need?

A sense of community responsibility

"conduct" – to conduct oneself with reference to one's obligations in relationship to others as part of some community

- A sense of the what the gospel was worth
- A unity around a mission bigger than themselves

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Timothy and Titus

Critical for perseverance in leaders

- Attention to their character across the span of their lives (live as one who knows God!)
- Attention to personal progress even amidst significant ministry
- Remain diligent in their responsibilities


